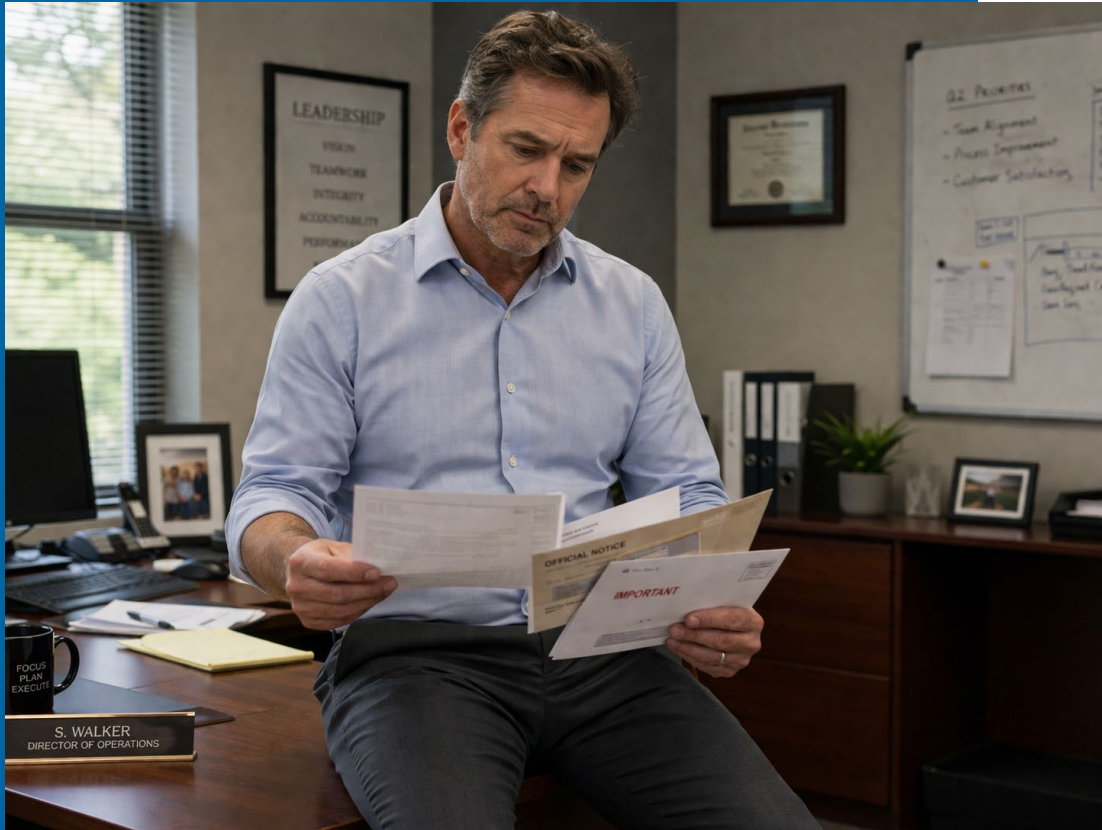
Question #1: Remote Employees

My business receives notices from various tax agencies.

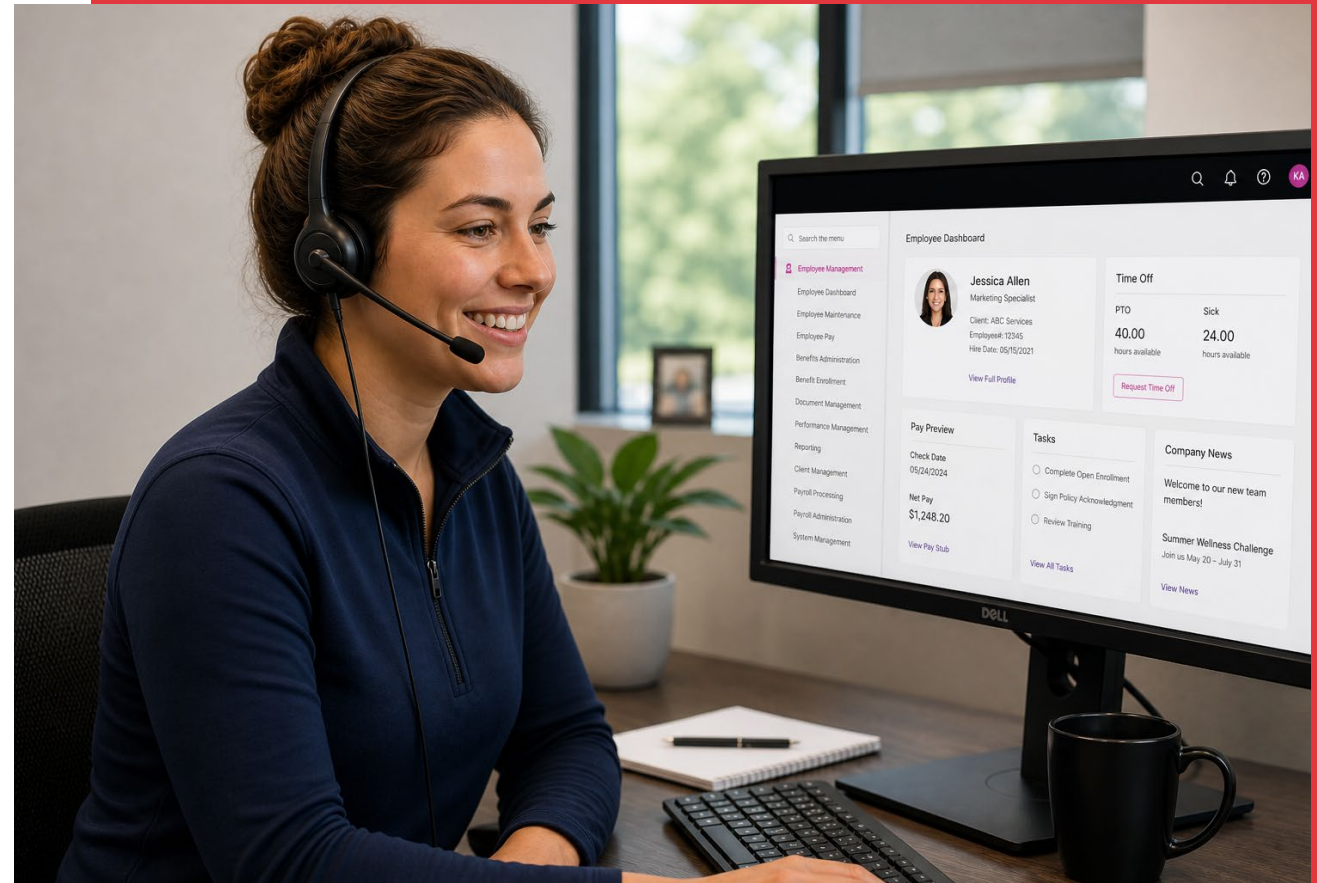
Does my payroll provider receive those as well?
